



HOW TO ENGAGE


This is a self-guided, drop-in session.

Please keep conversations respectful. All voices have value. Bullying, harassment, and abusive behaviour of any kind will not be tolerated.



As of September 29, 2023, ECSD has 3,619 Kindergarten to Grade 12 students enrolled in 12 different French Immersion sites.

Only 20% of students who start in Kindergarten graduate from Grade 12 in French Immersion.


ECSD has single-track French Immersion schools.

ECSD has Kindergarten with Full-Day Programming at four French Immersion schools.






KINDERGARTEN TO GRADE 6 BOUNDARIES






GRADE 7 TO GRADE 9 BOUNDARIES






What reasons do students leave the program after Grade 6?






